1. To confirm the minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 17th February 2017:

The minutes of the last meeting were circulated. Since no comments were received, the minutes were confirmed.

- Re-accreditation by NAAC: NMIMS University was reaccredited for the 3rd cycle in September 2017 by NAAC with the highest A+ grade and CGPA of 3.59 out of 4.
- Starting of New specializations: Considering the high demand for Business Analytics and Data Science, NMIMS has started new specializations of BTech. in Data Science and MSc.

in Artificial intelligence from academic year 2017-18. Also MSc (Finance) has started under the School of Commerce from 2017-18.

- 4. Interdisciplinary offerings of the courses: Interdisciplinary offerings of the courses master list has been built by 6 Schools of NMIMS, each school offering a course. All six courses will be offered to the students of these schools from academic year 2017-18.
- Development of In-house Learning Management System: The In-house LMS Student Portal is being developed and will be launched from academic year 2017-18.

6. To review the process of curriculum development:

The IQAC members desired to take a review of the status of implementation of the University's policy of incorporating incremental change in the curricula, delivery and evaluation every year to the extent of 10% to 20% and carrying out a structural change at the end of every three years. IQAC members of each school briefed the committee on the incremental changes which took place in the academic year 2016-17 and the proposed changes for the academic year 2017-18. The members also noted the disruptive changes in some programs being implemented from the academic year 2017-18.
