

Dual Degree in MBA Decision Science & Analytics + MS in Business Analytics & Information Management from Purdue University)

ADMISSION INFORMATION HANDOUT FOR GMAT/GRE Takers (Batch - 2022)

1. INTRODUCTION

This booklet gives information about the Admission Procedure **Dual Degree** in MBA Decision Science & Analytics + MS in Business Analytics & Information Management from Purdue University Program for academic year commencing from June 2022.

2. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

2.1 Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from recognized University with minimum 55% marks in aggregate (of all years) with Maths or Statistics or Econometrics as a subject in their graduation. The applicants should get minimum TOEFL score for 93 with minimum subsection scores, IELTS score of 7.0 or higher with minimum subsection scores as well will also accepted.

While NMIMS does not require any English language test score, however, this will be required by Purdue University. Hence, if candidates advance to the Purdue selection process, they must have the test score handy.

- Valid GMAT score (minimum 650) / GRE score (minimum 319) (GMAT score for last 5 years up to 31st January, 2022 will be considered) for the above mentioned candidates.
- Note1: Association of Indian Universities (AIU) equivalence certificate is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their graduation from overseas Universities. (http://www.aiu.ac.in)
- Note2: As per University Grants Commission (UGC) notification F. No. UGC/DEB/2013 dated 14.10.2013 "Degrees / Diplomas / Certificates awarded for programmes conducted by the Open & Distance Learning (ODL) institutions, recognized by Distance Education Council (DEC) (erstwhile) and UGC, in conformity with UGC Notification on specification of Degrees should be treated as equivalent to the corresponding awards of the Degree / Diploma / Certificate of the traditional Universities / institutions in the country".
- 2.2 Candidates who are appearing for the final examination of their Bachelor's degree are eligible to apply. Provisional admission is subject to clearing the final examination of their Bachelor's degree with 55 % aggregate marks (of all years) and selected candidates must produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the given stipulated time.



- 2.3 Candidates having two and more years of post-qualification work experience will be preferred.
- 2.4 The candidate must have appeared for all his subject(s) / examinations before the commencement of the respective program (s) of NMIMS (Deemed to-be-University). The examination of none of the subjects should be held after the commencement of the respective course. Also the candidate should be declared pass in all the above referred subjects (s) / examinations by the University from where he / she is graduating from, with minimum passing requirements (minimum 55% marks in the aggregate (of all years)). (However, in case the candidates' graduating University schedules the final year / semester / trimester examination/s (as applicable) during / after the commencement of the respective program the candidates' candidature may be considered subject to NMIMS (Deemed to be University) discretion).
- 2.5 At the time of admission, candidate has to produce semester-wise / trimester-wise / consolidated (only if individual mark sheets are not issued by University / Institute) mark sheets of all years of the college from which he/she has graduated. In case of internet copies of mark sheets, attestation by Principal with official seal is mandatory.
- 2.6 The candidates who have passed, or have appeared for graduation examination from a University where Grade Point Average is given, must produce the equivalent percentage for the GPA/ CGPA obtained in writing from the University concerned.
- 2.7 It is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualification for admission at NMIMS, as verification of the documents is done at the time of final admission.
- 2.8 If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/ her in the online registration is incorrect, his/ her application for the admission to the Programme, even if selected and fees paid, will stand cancelled and fees forfeited. Candidates appearing for Entrance test will do so at their own risk, eventually, forfeiting their admission for want of meeting the eligibility criteria. In such case registration charges, Program fee etc paid by candidate will be forfeited.

Interested candidates have to visit the NMIMS website for online registration.

- 4. Register Online on website www.nmims.edu & Pay registration fee of Rs. 2500/- plus applicable taxes (Nonrefundable). (Please refer to online registration for payment details).



5. SELECTION PROCESS

A. For NMIMS:

Please note that call letter for shortlisted candidate who needs to appear for entrance test will be uploaded on the NMIMS website www.nmims.edu

No Separate call letter will be mailed.

Prior to the selection process the candidate will be asked to share the following documents :

- Statement of Purpose (SOP): Reason for applying to the Programme, study interests, future career plans, etc.
- 10th Marksheet & Passing Certificate
- 12th Marksheet & Passing Certificate
- Degree Marksheet (for 1,2,3,4 years), separately for each semester/ trimester. Only if separate mark sheets are not issued by the University / Institute consolidated mark sheets will be accepted.
- Degree Certificate
- AIU Certificate (University Equivalence) is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their graduation from Overseas Universities.
- Work Experience Certificate
- TOEFL or IELTS score card (as applicable) (to be submitted at the time of NMIMS selection process)
- GMAT / GRE score card.
- Photo Identity Proof (Passport/PAN card/AADHAR card/Voter ID).

The above mentioned documents should be sent as scanned copies before NMIMS selection process, else they will not be considered for process.

The final decision of the University will be based on the GMAT /GRE score, Statement of Purpose, Entrance test score

At the time of admission in addition to above documents please submit the below mentioned documents also:

- Medical Insurance documents

6. FEES

The Fees for academic year 2022-2023 will be informed during entrance test. However, NMIMS fees for academic year 2021–2022 were Rs. 12,02,000/-.

7. REFUND OF FEES IN CASE OF WITHDRAWAL / CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

For cancellation/withdrawal of admission: Withdrawal/cancellation means voluntary withdrawal/cancellation by candidate for any reason. Please visit NMIMS website for online admission cancellation process: https://upload.nmims.edu/admission/cancellation/



8. **REFUND RULES**

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to the Institute
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally-notified last date of admission
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally-notified last date of admission
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally-notified last date of admission

In case of (1) in the table above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

Note: Candidates to refer Important Dates of the respective programme & refer refund rules mentioned in the offer letter.

9. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTION

- Candidate has to complete admission process with Purdue University after completing NMIMS admission process for admission into the program. For details of the Admission Process please visit https://sbm-purdue.nmims.edu/admission-process.php
- The selection criteria will be based on merit only. Decision regarding cut-off of the merit list will solely lie with NMIMS. The selection will be based on the merit score obtained by the candidate as well as on the availability of the seats in the programme. In this regard, the decision of the NMIMS will be final and undisputable and shall be binding on all concerned.
- Canvassing, in any form for admission will disqualify the candidate.
- All matters of dispute will be subject to the legal jurisdiction of Mumbai only.
- All communication to the candidates will be through NMIMS website only.
- Please note that No separate communication will be sent in this regard.
