

## B.A. (Honours) - Interior Environment and Design (Batch 2020-23)

### Information Handout

- 1) **Introduction:** This Handout gives information about 3-year program: **B.A. (Honours) Interior Environment and Design program** (Batch 2020-23)
- 2) **Intake & Duration:** 20 Seats & 3 years.  
Program will commence only if, there are a minimum of 20 eligible candidates after the selection process.
- 3) **Eligibility:**
  - 3.1 The candidate must have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination in any stream & must have obtained a minimum of **50% aggregate marks** at their 10+2 or equivalent examination **in first attempt**.
  - 3.2 **IB Candidates:** A candidate who has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination from IB Board should be either IB certificate or DP awarded with 24 credits compulsory, having passed 3 HL with minimum (12 credits) & 3 SL with minimum (9 credits) mandatorily from any stream.
  - 3.3 Candidates of **CBSE & ICSE**, should mention in the online registration / e-admission form (if selected) for 10+2 or equivalent examination, the aggregate marks of all the subjects the candidate has taken/opted and appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidate shall have passed all the subjects he / she has taken / opted and appeared in the applicable examination/s in a single / first attempt. The aggregate percentage of all subjects the candidate has taken / opted and appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program at the time of admission.
  - 3.4 In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects taken / opted and appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
  - 3.5 Candidates above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
  - 3.6 Those candidates who have passed or are appearing (all subject/s taken / opted) for 10+2 examination from a Board / University where Grade Point Average is given, such candidates must produce in writing from the Board / University concerned, the equivalent percentage for the GPA/CGPA obtained.
  - 3.7 Note for IB & Cambridge Candidate: Candidates who do not have final mark sheet will be given "Provisional Admission" based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet before the commencement of the program if found eligible. The candidate shall have to submit copy of AIU notification to confirm their eligibility for the program as equivalent to (10+2) examination/s. Marksheet/Transcripts issued by Board/University only be considered (School/Institute will not be accepted.)

- 3.8 International School/s candidates and those candidates who have completed their (10+2) or equivalent examination/s from overseas school/s / Institute/s / University will have to submit AIU certificate of equivalence (mandatory) to confirm their eligibility for the program as equivalent to (10+2) examination/s.
- 3.9 Only single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects taken / opted and passed in one / first attempt is mandatory, no compartmentalized mark sheet shall be considered.
- 3.10 The candidate who has NOT cleared the 10+2 or equivalent examination in the first attempt is NOT eligible to apply for the course.
- 3.11 Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college, failing which candidate will not be admitted to the course.
- 3.12 Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded/fail in the mark sheet /grade sheet. For absent/ungraded in any of the additional/non mandatory subject will be consider as eligible provided such candidate is declared as pass by respective board.

#### **4 Online Registration:**

##### **4.1 Online registration:**

- Before filling the online form, please read all the instruction carefully mentioned in instruction sheet & important dates

##### **4.2 Payment of registration fee:**

- Pay registration fee of Rs 1,800/- (Non-refundable) (Please refer online registration for payment details.) Registration fee is non-refundable.
- Appearing candidates should update their 10+2 examination marks before the last date of registration. Otherwise their application should not be considered for further selection / merit process.
- On the basis of information indicated in the Application Form, call letter for Personal Interview will be communicated to the candidate as per important dates through the NMIMS website.
- Candidates are required to download the call letter from our website [www.nmims.edu](http://www.nmims.edu) and upload below mentioned document. No separate call letter will be mailed or posted to the candidates. It is important and primary requirement to upload the mandatory documents before Personal Interview.

The list of mandatory documents is as follows:

- 10+2 Examination Passed Marksheet and Certificate
- 10 Examination Passed Marksheet and certificate
- Photo ID proof - Aadhaar Card / Passport / Voter ID / Driving License (Learner license will not be accepted).

- Candidate's application form will not be considered, if they fail to upload the above mentioned documents till 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2020 before 12.00 noon.
- No candidate without call letter will be permitted to appear for the written test & personal interview.

**5 Selection Process:**

- The Merit list will be prepared on the basis of the details provided by the candidate in application data in terms of academic marks at the 10+2 examination and Personal Interview conducted by NMIMS in Mumbai.
- The selection will be solely based on merit. In this regard, the decision of the NMIMS will be final and undisputable as also shall be binding on all concerned.

**6 Program Fees:**

Fees for Batch 2019-22 (Last year): Rs. 3,51, 500/- p.a.(for information only)

Fees for the current year will be intimated at the time of admission.

**7 Refund Rules:**The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows as per UGC rule October 2018:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is received in the Higher Educational Institutions (HEI)
(1)	100%	15 days or more <b>before</b> the formally-notified last date of admission ( <b>on or before 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2020</b> )
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days <b>before</b> the formally-notified last date of admission ( <b>4<sup>th</sup> August 2020 to 19<sup>th</sup> August 2020</b> )
(3)	80%	15 days or less <b>after</b> the formally-notified last date of admission ( <b>20<sup>th</sup> August 2020 to 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2020</b> )
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, <b>after</b> formally-notified last date of admission ( <b>4<sup>th</sup> September 2020 to 18<sup>th</sup> September 2020</b> )
(5)	00%	More than 30 days <b>after</b> formally-notified last date of admission ( <b>19<sup>th</sup> September 2020 onwards</b> )

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

Note: The above refund rules are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable).

**8 Important Instructions:**

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of 10+2 examination entered at the time of online registration. Therefore, it is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered.
- If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does **not** satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect i.e.10+2 examination Score, his/her admission to the course, even if selected, will stand cancelled and fees will be forfeited.
- Candidates of IB & Cambridge board will not be considered for admission /if admitted admission will be cancelled& fees will be refunded as per rule, if 10+2 or equivalent exam Score is less than predicted score mentioned in online registration form & does not fall within cut-off.
- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the NMIMS will be through its web site [www.nmims.edu](http://www.nmims.edu) and no individual communication will be sent to the candidate. **Kindly check website for regular updates**
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidates to ascertain whether they possess the necessary and requisite qualification for the admission to the courses at NMIMS.
- **For cancellation/ withdrawal of admission:** Withdrawal / cancellation means voluntary withdrawal / cancellation by candidate for any reason.
