
Objectives of the event


The event consisted of 3 rounds in total.

Objectives of the event:

- To create a simulated moot court setting to hone the researching, drafting and speaking skills of participants
- To ensure interaction with various legal professionals to gain real life exposure to the legal fraternity.
- To ensure creation of intra colligate ranks, which shall determine the participation of students in various national and international moot court competitions.

The 8th Intra Moot Court Competition, which was hosted by the Moot Court Committee of Kirit P Mehta School of Law, is an annual, co-curricular event, conducted in the Mithibai Building, wherein students from the second year till the fifth year are allowed to partake in a simulated court setting against each other. The event primarily has two stages, namely the Draw of Lots and the Oral Rounds. The Draw of Lots is conducted to create fixtures for all the participating teams in event. For the Oral Rounds, the committee invites associates from Tier 1 law firms to adjudicate the participants based on their arguing skills and their research which has gone into these arguments. The participants are also judged based on their written submissions that they submit to the judges. The approximate number of students that participate in this intra-colligate event, usually range from 250 to 300. The Faculty Convenor for this academic year was Ms Priya Kumari who was actively guiding us throughout the event. The Intra Moot Court Competition not only hones advocacy skills but also serves as a crucial selection process. Based on their performance in this competition, students are ranked and chosen to represent the School at various national and international moot court competitions. This recognition allows them to showcase their talent on a wider stage, gain valuable experience.



Outcome of the event

Sixteen selected papers were presented in the conference and seven in the research colloquium. Soumya Sankar Chakraborty, Research Scholar, HSS, IIT Bombay and Dr. Subramania Raju Rajasulochana, Associate Professor, SBM Mumbai won the Best Paper Award that carried a certificate and a cash prize of Rs. 7500.
